COLONY MOREPUKUR, RISHRA, HOOGHLY-712248, hereinafter called the 'Settler/ Chairman' (which expression shall mean & include her heirs, executors, administrators, assign and representatives) of the ONE PART.

By Laws

A. Trust Fund

- i. That the trust Fund may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
- That the trusties shall always maintain proper accounts of the trust which shall be kept at the office.

A. Operation of Bank Account

To open account in the name of the Trust. The account shall be operated by Settler/ Chairman.

B. Period of Trustees

Settler/ Chairman will be for Lifetime and Settler/ Chairman can change to Trustee at any time.

Honorary Member of the trust will be Members or new Joined Member of the Trust Joined time to time.

- C. During the life time of Founder member, he can appoint his nominee and after his death the appointed nominee and in case none is appointed then the legal heir will enjoy all the rights of the founder as presently the founder is enjoying. This process of nomination or successor shall continue till the working of the Trust. To repeat the Settler or the nominee's shall continue to hold all those powers at present at present enjoyed by the Settler.
- **D. Power of Trustees**. That for the furtherance of the objects of the Trust, the Trustees shall have the following powers.
 - 1. Chairman will be (i) preside over all meetings of "MARG DARSHIKA" and (ii) take all disciplinary actions such as removal, dismissal etc., in consultation with the Governing Body, against any member of "MARG DARSHIKA". To appoint or make provision for the appointment of any person (including all or any of Trustees and committees or administrator of Chairman or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the Trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees any prescribe and also to appoint or provide to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject to such rules and regulation as the Trustees may from time to time think fit.
 - 2. Chairman will sign and give pay order on all bills for payments; (i) ensure that annual and other statutory returns are submitted to the proper authorities timely and in accordance with the provisions of the Act concerned; (ii) advice the Governing Body in all matters of policy regarding programs, finance, property and administration; (iii)

appoint all staff (iv) Be responsible for the implementation of the policies and programs of "MARG DARSHIKA"; and (v) transact all other business subject to the direction of the Governing Body.

- 3. To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or in kind, from any person (s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.
- 4. To apply the whole or any part of the income of the trust, or the trust fund or accumulations thereto, to any one or more of the objects of the trust, as the trustees, may, in their discretion deem fit from time to time.
- 5. To convert and deal with the trust property and/or any investments for the time being.
- 6. To borrow or raise or secure payments of moneys and also to lend money either with or without security.
- 7. To sell, dispose of alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust Fund.
- 8. To invest the Trust Fund either in the purpose of mortgage of immovable property or in shares, stock or debentures or other securities and investments, or in deposits with or loans to any company, bank firm or any other person, and to alter very or transpose such investments from time to time at the discretion of the trustees.
- 9. To let out, demise any immovable property comprised in the Trust Fund for such period and at such rent on such terms and conditions as the Trustees in their discretion may think fit.
- 10. To adjust, settle, compromise, compound, refer to arbitration all actions, suits claims demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.

E. Office Bearers of the Trust:

The board of Trustees shall have different office bearers like Chairman, and Trustee looking after the functional areas of the Trust activities. The selection of such office bearers will be made by the Board of Trustees consisting of all appointments/ selection of the office bearers and their duties and response shall be decided in the meeting of the Trustees in consultation with settler.

F. Decision by Settler/ Chairman at Meeting:

All decisions at any meeting shall be taken by Settler/ Chairman.

G. Resolution by Circulation:

The Trustees may transact the business of the Trust by means of resolutions circulated to all the Trustees for the time being in India as well as abroad and voted upon favorable by a majority of them and all work can't be done without permission of Settler/ Chairman.

H. Quorum:

There shall be quorum when two trustees are present at any meeting. Pending any vacancy the Trustees for the time being less in number than the quorum may act for ails purposes in the administration of the Trust.

Governing Body Meeting: It shall meet at least three times in a year at such place and time as the Chairman and Vice Chairman determines. The meetings shall be summoned by the Chairman and Vice Chairman by giving a notice of 7 days and specifying the agenda therein.

Requisite Meeting: Any two members of the Governing Body may request a requisite meeting of the Governing Body upon a written petition to the Chairman of Vice Chairman mentioning the business to be dealt with in such a meeting. The quorum shall include the requisition with additional to five members.

I. Office. Campus, Staff & Others:

The Trustees shall be at liberty to establish offices in different parts of the world, to develop campus and appoint permanent, temporary, casual and honorary staff consisting administrators, advisors, scientists and related persons as may be necessary to carry out the Trust purposes and to pay them the right salary or honorarium.

J. Donation to other Organization:-

it shall be lawful for the Trustees to give and by way of donations out of the income or corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise to different institutions, societies organizations of Trust in India or other countries which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for like purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such Institutions. Societies Organizations or Trust to start maintain or carry out objectives as mentioned in these or any of them.

K. Pooling resources with others:

1) The Trustees may join hands and pool the resources of the Trust with other persons including Governmental and international funding agencies and Trustees of other similar Trust and their resources for the better promotion of all or any of the Trust purposes.

- 2) To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulation for carrying out the objects of Trust and for the management of the affairs thereof for giving effect to the objects of the Trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the Trust.
- 3) To start, abolish, discontinue and restart any charity or charitable institutions for the benefit of general public and to impose any conditions to any subscription or donation made by them.
- 4) To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the Trust.
- 5) To join, co-operate or amalgamate this trust with other or others having kindred or/and ahead objects upon such terms and conditions as the trustees may in their discretion think fit, particularly having regard to and in conformity with the objects and nature or the Trust.
- 6) To give aid by way of donations out of the income or the corpus of the Trust fund or otherwise to different charitable institutions societies, organizations or Trusts in India which may have been established or which may hereafter be established for the like charitable purposes mentioned in these presents or any of them to enable such institution, societies, organization or Trustees to start maintain or carry out such charitable objects.
- 7) To settle all accounts and to compromise, compound, abandon, or refer to arbitration any action or proceedings or disputes, claim demand or things as deemed proper for such purpose without being responsible for any loss occasioned thereby.
- 8) To borrow moneys either on the security of any property comprised in the Trust Fund or otherwise for all or any of the purposes of these presents and it shall be lawful for the Trustees to make such borrowings on payment of such interest and otherwise on such terms and condition as they may in their absolute discretion think tit.
- 9) To apply to the Government, public bodies, urban, local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts subscription, and other assistance with the Government Departments, Public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to confirm to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.
- 10) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association, or institution with similar objects.
- 11) To establish, promote, mange, organize or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting managing, organizing, or maintaining any branch or Trust or any other Trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this Trust with this Trust.

- 12) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to-the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be thought expedient.
- 13) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.
- 14) To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the trust, societies, institutions or associations with which this trust is authorized to amalgamate,
- 15) To transfer and hand over the Trust to any Society. Corporation, Institution, Trust or Organization on such terms and conditions as the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to behold by the Society, Corporation. Institution, Trust or Organization with the power, provisions, agreements and declarations, appearing and contained in these presents subject to such modifications as may be necessary and consequent to such transfer of the Trust fund. The Trustees for the time being of these presents shall become discharges from the Trust hereof relating to Trust Funds so transferred.
- 16) The Trustees shall be accountable only for such moneys, stocks, shares and funds as shall actually come into their hands and a Trustee shall not be answerable or accountable for neglect, default, acts or omission or commission of the other Trustees, nor of any banker or other person with whom the trust properties or any securities may have been deposited or kept.
- 17) The Trustees will not be entitled to receive any remuneration, but the Trustees may reimburse themselves all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with the Trust or their duties relating thereto.
- 18) The number of the Trustees shall not be less than two and more than seven. If the numbers of filling any vacancy act so long number is below the said minimum.
- 19) The Chairman for the time being will be at liberty to appoint additional Trustees within the number mentioned above for such period or on such terms as to retirement and reappointment as the Trustees for the time being consider proper. A person shall cease to be a Trustee either.
 - (i) If without leave or absence does not attend three consecutive meetings of the Trustees or for one calendar year, whichever is longer.
- 20) Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his Intention to do so.

And Hours

- 21) The Trustees may from time to time frame rules for the conduct and regulations of the meeting of Trustees. In the absence of such regulations:
 - (i) Two Trustees shall form a quorum for a meeting of the Trustees,
 - (ii) All matters will be decided mutually by the Trustees.
 - (iii) Resolution passed without any meeting of the Trustees but by circulation thereof and evidence in writing under the hands of two thirds of the Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as a Resolution duly passed at a Meeting or Trustees.
- 22) The Trustees shall have the power to determine in case of doubt whether any moneys or property shall for the purpose of the charity be considered as capital or income and whether out of income or capital any expenses or outgoings ought to be paid or borne and every such determination shall be binding and conclusive provided that nothing contained shall be deeded to authorize the Trustees to spend the income or corpus of the Trust for any purpose not authorized by these presents.
- 23) The accounting year of the Trust shall be the financial year ending on 31st March every year.
- 24) The Trust and the Trust funds shall be and irrevocable for all times.
- 25) The Office of the Trust shall be situated at Delhi unless changed by the Trustees by two-third majority and any other State and abroad.
- 26) It is expressly declared that no part of the Trust property or its income or any accretion thereto shall be applied for any purpose outside India or for any purpose which is not a charitable purpose in law, and all provisions hereof shall be construed accordingly.
